# Bedford Duo Paces Hockey Star Squad

Scoring champion Tim Rollman and runner-up Max Wiard, both of Bedford, are on the first team Northwest Ohio High School Hockey League All-Star squad chosen by the league's coaches.

Also on the first team are Sylvania Southview's Doug Dibble, a forward as are Rollman and Wiard, defensemen Greg Fox of Macomber and John Glaab of St. Francis, and goaltender Richard Van Camp of Woodward.

Rollman was the league assist leader with 43 and he totaled 79 points. Wiard topped the league in goals with 42 and had 71 points.

Fox was fifth in scoring with 61 points, best for a defenseman. Glaab, another offensive-minded defenseman, racked up 56 points to finish seventh in league scoring.

Van Camp had 526 saves in 18 league games as Woodward finished second in its division with a 12-6 record.

Central Catholic's Mark McClear, and Mike Morey and Mark Switala, both of St. John's, defensemen Jeff Stanger of Central, and Jim Schultz of Bedford, and goalie Mark Hamilton of St. Francis.

Morey was third in league scoring with 70 points, coming on 37 goals and 33 assists. Switala was the fourth best scorer with 68 points.

In weekend action, Lake goalie Rich Abee had 42 saves, 22 in the last period,

in the Flyers' win that was made possible by scores from Randy Akenberger, Kevin Winkle, and Doug Domonkos.

Geof VanSickle tallied the winning goal in overtime as Ottawa Hills upset St. John's, 7-6. OH goaltender Matt Hatcher turned away 40 shots, but not four by Titan Mike Morey, who also had one assist.

Waite, the only undefeated team in league play, closed out its season with a 5-1 victory over Woodward as five players scored goals. Todd Wilkinson and Jeff Smith each had two assists for Waite.

Central grabbed two wins, a 7-5 verdict over Bedford with Mark MacAlear getting the hat trick, and a 10-1 decision over Start with Rory Ruff tallying two goals.

In the battle of Sylvania rivals,

Northview's Mano Gartner scored just 35 seconds into overtime to defeat Southview, 6-5. Bob Napierala had two goals for Northview and Doug Dibble had a pair for Southview.
